

2024 Tournament Rules

Tee off

- Two teams of 4 players begin at each hole.
- Two foursomes playing the hole concurrently, maintaining the scores of their foursome for the entirety of the tournament
- Both teams of 4 tee off **TOGETHER**.

Scramble Format

- Each team member may place the ball within one club length of the selected shot, but no nearer the hole.
- There is a maximum of two putts per hole.

Fast Pass

- The Fast Pass is played on hole 6.
- Players go past tee blocks until they are 100 yards out. This is where all players tee off for this hole.

GIMME Shot

- The GIMME may be used on any hole (except a designated hole-in-one) once you have reached the green.
- You must determine if you are going to use the GIMME prior to putting.
- Once you have decided to use your GIMME, pick up your ball and move on to the next hole.
- Mark your score for that hole, including the GIMME shot. Example: On the green in 1 plus the GIMME, score is 2.

Grenade Throw

- The Grenade shot may be used on any hole (except a designated hole-in-one).
- If your approach shot lands near the green or in the sand, the team can pick up the ball and **throw it** towards the flag at no penalty.
- Mark your score for that hole, not including the Grenade shot.
- You cannot use the Grenade shot to be eligible for a hole prize (closest to the pin, etc).

Hole-In-One Rules

- Every registered golfer is eligible to win.
- Drive must be made from designated tee blocks.
- Witnesses are provided at each hole-in-one location.
- To be eligible for prize, **all golfers must tee off from the men's tee blocks.**
- Hole-In-Ones are located on holes 4, 8, 10, 15 and 17.

Flights

- Will be determined after completion of 18 holes.
- Turn in your scorecard at the end of play.

Longest Putt

- For the Longest Putt there will be a stake in the ground.
- If you make your ball in that is further than where the stake currently is, move the stake to where you putted and write down your name.
- The Longest Putt is found on holes 1, 11, 13, and 18.

Longest Drive in Fairway

- For the Longest Drive in the Fairway, if you out-drive where the stake currently is, move the stake to where your ball landed and write down your name.
- The Longest Drive in Fairway is located on holes 2, 7, and 14.

On the Green Contest

- If you land on the green with your tee shot, you are entered into a drawing to win a prize.
- The On the Green Contest is on hole 4 and hole 10.

Closest to Pin

- For the Closest to Pin contest, if your tee off is closer to the pin than where the stake currently is, move stake and write down your name.
- The Closest to Pin is found on holes 8, 15, and 17.

Closest to Pin on 2nd Shot

- On your 2nd shot, whoever is closest to the pin wins a prize.
- If you are closest to the pin, move the stake and write down your name.
- The Closest to Pin on 2nd shot is found on hole 5.

Straightest Drive

- For the straightest drive, a line is drawn in the fairway.
- If your drive is closest to the flag at the end of said line, move the stake, and write down your name.
- The Straightest Drive is found on hole 12.

Shortest Drive

- If your drive is the shortest, move the stake and write down your name.
- The Shortest Drive is found on hole 16.

50/50 Putting Challenge

- You will begin at the line/St. Anthony Flag.
- If you make the putt into the cup, you are entered into the 50/50 drawing.
- Every time you putt and make it, your name gets added to the bucket.
- The 50/50 Putting Challenge is found on the putting green.

Chipping Contest

- For the Chipping Contest all players chip from a designated line.
- Everyone that makes their ball into the circle that is around the pin is entered into a drawing.
- The Chipping Contests are found on the chipping green and near hole 15.
